

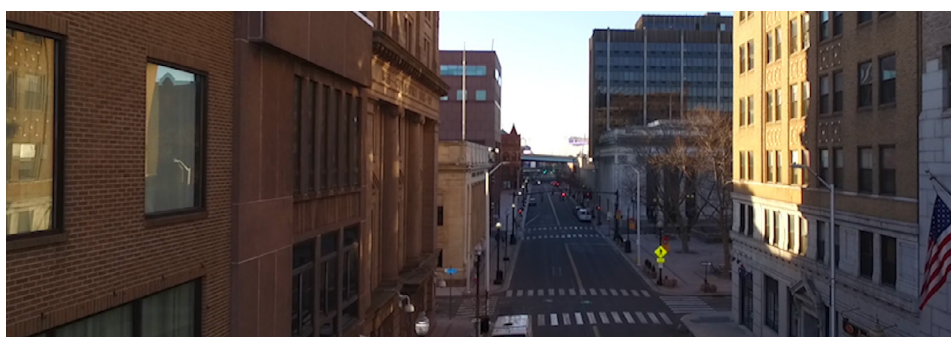
Do you live in Bridgeport?

Get your MUNICIPAL ID CARD today!



IDs can be used for:

- Form of identification
- Proof of residence
- Access to select banking services
- Access to city services
- File a complaint with the Police Department
- Access and obtain some discounts to restaurants, museums, movies, libraries, and health, multicultural and recreation centers.



Anyone can obtain an ID

- ALL residents of Bridgeport can obtain the ID Card regardless of their age, ethnicity, immigration status or prior criminal record.

How to obtain an ID

1

You must prove your identity and residence in the City of Bridgeport. Listed below are examples of acceptable documents:

Identity:

- Passport
- Brith Certificate
- Green Card
- Visa
- Driver's License
- Social Securiy Card

Proof of Residence:

- Utility Bills
- Pay Stub
- Letter from School
- Home, Lease, Rent Agreement
- Bank Account Statement

Display your documentation.

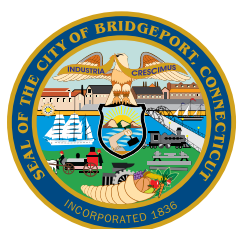
Obtain a Municipal ID by going to the Vital Records Department at 999 Broad Street, Bridgeport, Connecticut and show required documentation.

Make Payment.

Receive your Municipal ID after you make your payment, **only \$15.**

Valid for 3 years.
