3. Examiner's Report – Fire Assistant Chief #2329

The Examiner's Report for the Fire Assistant Chief exam #2329 was submitted for review. Mr. Dunn stated that Lisa Kollman, Examiner, was out of the office and he read the report into the Record.

4. Certification of Employment List for Fire Assistant Chief #2329 – Approved

On a motion made by Commissioner Plummer and seconded by Commissioner Rodgers the Commission unanimously certified the employment list for Fire Assistant Chief Exam #2329.

5. Examiner's Report – Police Sergeant #2326

The Examiner's Report for the Police Sergeant exam #2326 was submitted for review. Mr. Dunn read the report into the Record in Ms. Kollman's absence. Mr. Dunn stated that Stacey Lyons, a female, scored the highest on the exam. There are over 88 names on the list. Mr. Dunn said the department has 10 vacancies currently. Additionally, Mr. Dunn explained that 4 candidates were eliminated during the oral examination due to having an electronic device at the oral examination and this is prohibited. All 4 appealed; 1 withdrew his appeal and 3 appeals will be heard in August. 2 other appeals were filed that Mr. Dunn believes are of a general nature because no specific complaint was written in the request for an appeal. Mr. Dunn recommended that the certification of the list not be held up. If an appeal is granted then the employee will be made whole. Attorney Mitola stated that the rankings at the top of the list would not be impacted if appeals are granted.

6. Certification of Employment List for Police Sergeant #2326 – Approved, Pending Appeals

On a motion made by Commissioner Plummer and seconded by Commissioner Rodgers the Commission unanimously certified the employment list for Police Sergeant #2326 *pending appeals in August 2014*.

7. Firefighter #2306 Employment List – Expires August 27, 2014 - Contingent Offers of Employment – Tabled

There was a discussion about approving 25 contingent offers of employment to candidates ranked #70 to #94 on the employment list. This employment list expires August 27, 2014. Mr. Dunn would still have to speak with the Administration. On a motion made by Commissioner Rodgers and seconded by Commissioner Plummer the Commission unanimously tabled this matter to the August Commission meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:53 p.m.
