

**CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2010
CITY HALL, CIVIL SERVICE CONFERENCE ROOM
MINUTES**

Commissioner Guedes called the special meeting of the Civil Service Commission to order at 10:19 a.m. Present were Commissioners Correa, McBride, and Rodgers. Also present were Acting Personnel Director David Dunn and Clerk to the Commission Deborah Brelsford. Attorneys for the City of Bridgeport (Mark Anastasi, John Mitola, and John Bohannon) and attorneys representing Mr. MacNicholl (Richard Albrecht and Heather Spaide) were also present. Commissioner Plummer joined the meeting at 10:29 a.m.

Attorney Bohannon presented legal arguments against the Commission hearing the MacNicholl appeal, because the hiring list had expired. Attorneys Albrecht and Spaide presented legal arguments for the MacNicholl appeal to be heard by the Commission. On a motion made by Commissioner Plummer and seconded by Commissioner Rodgers, Executive Session began at 11:48 a.m.

The Commission meeting returned to Public Session at 12:25 p.m.

A motion was made by Commissioner Correa and seconded by Commissioner Plummer, to hear the MacNicholl appeal. Commissioner Rodgers voted to hear the MacNicholl appeal. Commissioner McBride was not eligible to vote. The Commissioners voted unanimously to table the matter to the regular Civil Service Commission meeting on Tuesday, March 9, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. (time change).

A motion was made by Commissioner Plummer and seconded by Commissioner Correa to adjourn the meeting at 12:30 p.m.
