Council

CDBG, HESG, HOME and HOPWA Programs

The City of Bridgeport is required to prepare and submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) an Annual Action Plan for CDBG, HESG, HOME and HOPWA programs. The primary objectives of the CDBG Program are to provide decent housing, a suitable living environment, and to expand economic opportunities principally for persons of low to moderate income. The City must give maximum feasible priority to those activities that will meet those objectives and no less than 70% of the City's allocations must benefit low- and moderate-income persons. The City has estimated that at least 90% of its programs will benefit low- and moderate-income persons.

The City's Citizens' Union and the Special Committee on CDBG held its virtual joint public hearings on Wednesday, March 23, 2022 and Thursday, March 24, 2022. The Citizens Union deliberations took place on Tuesday, March 29, 2022, and the Special Committee on CDBG deliberations took place on Wednesday, March 30, 2022. The Bridgeport City Council voted on Monday, April 18, 2022 to approve the activity funding levels. The results of the full Council vote on activities approved for funding (the draft PY48 Annual Action Plan) are available for review and public comment at the Office of Community Development, City of Bridgeport, Margaret E. Morton Government Center, 999 Broad Street, Bridgeport, CT 06604, between the hours of 9am – 5pm, Monday – Friday, and on the City of Bridgeport's webpage at <https://www.bridgeportct.gov/hcd>, until May 20, 2022. There is a minimum 30-day public comment period on the draft plan. This comment period ends at noon on Friday, May 20, 2022.
