Airport Access and Identification Badge Certification

In addition to strict adherence to Sikorsky Memorial Airport's policies, procedures and any applicable Federal, State or Local Laws; the following rules and restrictions shall be observed to by all users issued an individual airport access and identification badge:

- Prior to accepting a badge, the recipient will have successfully completed both the:
 - Sikorsky Memorial Airport Safety and Security Training Presentation available at the Airport's current website, and
 - AOPA's online General Aviation Security Course appropriate for their role available at: <https://www.aopa.org/training-and-safety/online-learning/online-courses>.
- Badges will only be issued to those individuals who own or operate an aircraft based at the airport, have a sanctioned commercial business or operation, or who can demonstrate a substantive need for airport access.
- Access Badges are the sole property of the City of Bridgeport/Sikorsky Memorial Airport and must be returned upon request, following a violation, or if the previously demonstrated need for the badge is terminated or has changed.
- Vehicle or pedestrian access to the Movement Areas is strictly prohibited unless the driver is specifically authorized by an airport official and has completed the Sikorsky Memorial Airport Driver Training Program and passed the practical exam issued by an airport representative.
- All vehicles and persons entering and exiting airport access points must ensure all gates and doors are fully closed before proceeding to their intended destination.
- Badges authorize access for the individual specifically identified on this form. Sharing badges is strictly prohibited.
- Visitors and guests must be escorted by a badged airport user and remain under their direct and continuous supervision at all times.
- Badges allow access only to the location(s) specifically listed on this form. Transitioning to or from another location via the Air Operations Area (OA) is strictly prohibited.
- Lost or misplaced badges must be immediately reported to an airport official and are subject to a \$30 replacement fee. Temporary access cards are subject to a \$5 daily charge.
- Badges must be carried and properly displayed while on the AOA.
