BRIDGEPORT, CT – Superintendent Testani announced there will be emergency food service sites available during school closings from March 13 until March 20th, 2020. The designated schools will be open Monday through Friday to provide breakfast and lunch for all Bridgeport students. Kitchen staff will work their regularly scheduled hours: 7:30AM to 1:30PM. Students must be 18 years old and under, children ages 10 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

- Breakfast will be offered at each location from 8:30AM to 9:30AM
- Lunch service will be available from 11:30AM to 12:30PM
