School Building Committee V. <u>Bassick High School – Procore Proposal</u>

School Construction Program requested the approval to utilize Procore as the Construction Financial Management Software for Bassick High School. Previously the team utilized Expedition but it was housed on the City system and removed in 2018. There has been no software since then and the team has to catch up on three (3) years' worth of contracts and invoices to. The rational for utilizing Procore is the Construction Manager is also utilizing the program, due to this, School Construction is able to get a better rate. Procore is based on the entire cost of the project but due to the Construction Manager utilizing it, Procore was able to deduct the value of construction owned by them.

The software costs \$11,282 per year with a setup fee of \$15,000.

Discussion: Mr. Urquidi asked if there would be any concerns of the program becoming obsolete as did Expedition. Mrs. Otero explained that Expedition is not obsolete, however could not be housed on the City server any longer, that is why it was terminated. Mr. Brown asked if this would help School Construction with project close out with the State; Mrs. Otero replied, YES.
