Mr. Amado announced that Mr. Taveras was not present. Mr. Amado also gave a brief overview of the details.

The Commission has received a request for an appeal from Chevonne Spinks regarding her disqualification from the hiring process for the Public Safety Telecommunicator examination #2383 due to failing a portion of the medical examination.

Mr. Amado informed the Commissioners that Ms. Spinks was withdrawing her appeal. No action was necessary at this time.

11. Appeal – Christopher Moore

The Commission has received a request for an appeal from Christopher Moore regarding his disqualification from the hiring process for the seasonal position of Golf Course Groundskeeper, due to failing a portion of the medical examination.

Mr. Amado asked Mr. Moore if he wished to have his appeal hearing in Executive Session or Public Session. Mr. Moore stated that he would prefer the appeal be held in public session. Mr. Amado reminded everyone that the City still includes marijuana in the safety sensitive function classification.

Mr. Moore said that he had been working for the City for three years and had no issues during that time. He said that his boss would rehire him. Atty. Mitola said that the Commission would likely deny the appeal and Mr. Moore could re-apply for the position tomorrow morning.

Session. He then came forward and said he had worked for the City for five years. Atty. Mitola said that the Commission would likely deny the appeal and Mr. Jackson could re-apply for the position tomorrow morning.
