\$5.00 per week if below 185% USDA Income Eligibility guideline

\$10.00 per week if over 185% but below Income 210% USDA Income Eligibility guideline

\$20.00 per week if over 210% USDA Income Eligibility guideline

Registration Fee:

For Families below the 185% USDA Income Eligibility guideline for their family size, the \$25.00 registration fee shall be applied toward the first five week's payment

Multiple Children:

For families below the 185% USDA Income Eligibility guideline for their family size who are able to pay, the following shall apply:

First Child is full price at \$5.00 Second Child is half price at \$2.50 Three or more children are free

To qualify families please ask them to provide the top sheet of their most recent Tax Return or two recent consecutive paystubs for <u>each</u> working family member. Parents who are <u>unable or unwilling</u> to provide this information may still register but should do so with the Site Coordinator. No child regardless of where they fall on the scale above shall be turned away based on ability to pay.
