- Entry level Police Officer -- Test results have been received for the September 30th written exam. Oral exams will be scheduled soon. The Police class may start October 16th.

- The Public Safety Telecommunicator Examination will be reopened in the coming weeks.
- Fire Lieutenant A competitive exam is being coordinated.
