

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL BOARD MEETING OF

**Barros Hearing  
Discipline Decision**

This meeting was called to order at **6:19 PM**

On a motion by Commissioner Cruz and seconded by Commissioner Farrow, the Board unanimously voted to go into executive session at **6:21 PM**

**Public Session: 6:33 PM**

**Item a.: OIA Case # 231-190 (Officer Martin Pizighelli)** – On a motion by Commissioner Lyons and Seconded by Commissioner Farrow, the board unanimously voted to uphold the following charges in the Office of Internal Affairs Case # 231-190 and found Officer Martin Pizighelli in violation of department rules and regulations: 10.08 IV C (Records Management- Release of information (#1 and 2)), 10.08 O (Records Management – Juvenile records), and 10.08.3 (Access to Records). For these violations of department rules and regulations, Officer Pizighelli has been issued a written warning and four (4) hours of retraining in the area record management. This discipline will be on Officer Pizighelli’s record for one year. It is understood and agreed that no grievance will be filed by Officer Pizighelli or the Union in connection with the violations and/or discipline imposed. It is further understood by all parties that this agreement shall not be precedent or model for the resolution or settlement of any further claim resulting from similar or different circumstances.

**Item b.: OIA Case # 231-193 (Sergeant Alexander Wilde)** – On a motion by Commissioner Cruz and seconded by Commissioner Farrow, the Board voted unanimously to uphold the following charge in the Office of Internal Affairs Case # 231-193 and found Sergeant Wilde in violation of department rules and regulations: 5.09 M.5 (Traffic Enforcement Policy – Read the post-Arrest Warning). For violation of this department rule and regulation, Sergeant Wilde has been issued a verbal warning to be held on his record for six (6) months. Sergeant Wilde will also undergo four (4) hours of retraining in DUI arrest procedure. It is understood and agreed that no grievance will be filed by Sergeant Wilde or the Union in connection with the violation and/or discipline imposed. It is further understood by all parties that this agreement shall not be precedent or model for the resolution or settlement of any further claim resulting from similar or different circumstances.

**Item c.: OIA Case # 231-197 (Officer Roderick Doda)** – On a motion by Commissioner Cruz and seconded by Commissioner Lyons, the Board voted unanimously to uphold the following charge in the Office of Internal Affairs Case # 231-197 and found Officer Doda in violation of department rules and regulations: 1.01B – 2.17 (Use of Tobacco). For violation of this department rule and regulation, Officer Doda has been issued a non-disciplinary verbal counseling. It is understood and agreed that no grievance will be filed by Officer Doda or the Union in connection with the violation and/or discipline imposed. It is further understood by all parties that this agreement shall not be precedent or model for the resolution or settlement of any further claim resulting from similar or different circumstances.
